

What do you see? Jer. 1. 11. The eye is the lamp of the body. Mt. 6,22-23

I n this third month of a spectacular year, we have an opportunity to work much more closely with the Lithing Person in the Trinity to enlarge and sharpen our vision. The Lord gave us the ability to see into three realms--with our physical, mental and spiritual eyes. all realms.

Prov. 29.18. The Lord told Abraham to walk through the land after Lot left him. Gen. 13. 14-17. It also explains how only two of Israel's twelve leaders believed that they can possess the promised land the Lord assigned them. They actually possessed it while the others perished.

It is also no wonder that Satan's immediate action against God's children once he captures them is to put out their eyes as with Samson and Zedekiah, Judah's last king before exile. (Judges 16. 21, 2Kgs 25.7). Similarly, the false prophet, Bar Jesus who obstructed the gospel was blinded (2 Kgs 6.18, Acts 9.9, 13.8-11).

What are you expected to do to actualize this transformation in your life, family, church, city, community and nation? An important clue is to seek for the fresh fire of the Holy Spirit at His altar so He can equip you with His gifts and fruit. It is the path to revival and recovery at all levels, times and regions.
